

Notes from the NTC Fall Conference:

HR 814 Provide collective bargaining rights for public safety officers employed by Statutes or their political subdivision. No movement.

HR 764 A bill to extend the authorization of the Bulletproof Vest Partnership Grant Program. Authorized \$50 million dollars and has used \$25 million. Law Enforcement Steering committee Comprised of national official groups, management, labor and research groups We share our priorities with Attorney General Ashcroft. Meet once a month and discuss issues for each group. The agreed issues are then discussion to congress and legislature.

HR 3266 To authorize the Secretary of Homeland Security to make grants to first responders, and for other purposes. It has recently been amended into **HR 10**

Patriot Act Renewed the sunset clause.

HR 814 To provide collective bargaining rights for public safety officers employed by States or their political subdivisions. No movement.

HR1708 To extend the authorization of the Bulletproof Vest Partnership grant program. Authorized \$50 million only used \$25 million. Referred to Ho& subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism and homeland Security.

HR2967 Law Enforcement Officers Bill of Rights Provide standards and procedures to guide both State and local law enforcement agencies and law enforcement officers during internal investigations, interrogation and law enforcement officers, and administrative disciplinary hearings. and to ensure accountability of law enforcement officers guarantee the due process rights of law enforcement officers. and to require States to enact law enforcement discipline. accountability and due process laws. No movement.

HR3815 To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide expanded protections against the misuse of Public safety officer uniforms. and for other purposes. 3/1/2004 Referred to House subcommittee. Status: Referred to the Subcommittee on Crime, Terrorism and Homeland Security.
