Dear Members of the Parole Board:

I am writing on behalf of the National Troopers Coalition and its over 45, 000 members representing Troopers and Highway Patrol Officers from throughout the nation.

We vehemently request that you put aside any consideration for a reduction or change in the sentence of Gregory Powell.

Powell appears to be now using his terminal cancer illness as a plea for his early release. Under normal circumstances, a terminally ill patient would be worthy of all compassion and humanitarian efforts to ease his pain in whatever means could be achieved.

But in this case, the priority is keeping a murderer incarcerated. We cannot allow a murderer whose impact has been so significant and earth shattering to Officer Campbell's family, friends and his department, to deter us in not having any sympathy for this person.

There is no relief that will make whole the Campbell family. To alter Powell's sentence would be a slap in the face to Officer Campbell's memory.
